Gala 2021

The treasure hunts are prepared and Rosemary will send pdfs to the Vicarage for printing at the beginning of June - 100 of the main one and 50 of the children's one. It was decided that 2 boxes would be situated in the Coop for the returned forms with a cut off time of 5pm on Sunday, Jo to collect and mark the main one and Hayley to collect and mark the children's one. The Coop and the Post Office will be selling the main treasure hunt maps for £2 each and the children's one can be picked up free or downloaded from the website. If there are a few winners of the children's treasure hunt the names will be put into a hat, Hayley is to buy some sweets from S & J Pick & Mix Sweets for a prize. The main Treasure Hunt has a prize of £10 and a shield which can be presented after engraving. All winners and the answers will be posted online.

37 scarecrows have been promised so far; the map will be a free download from the website. We only have one wheelbarrow but it will also be marked on the map together with where the yarn-bombing is situated. Tracey and Rosemary will judge the scarecrows on Thursday and leave certificates for the winners to display. The prize money, £30, £20 & £10 will be given out at the time and the shield presented after engraving. Winners will be posted online.

St Hybald's Church is doing some yarn bombing and there is to be some live music by Earth Folk, Keith Duke and Polly Brown, on Saturday at 11am and 2pm. Other areas to be yarn bombed are; Village Green, Church Lane, Chapel Lane, Vicarage Lane Bus Shelter, 4 Lidgett Close, Mill Lane and the Coop.

Neil said he would contact Peter Papworth about classic vehicles, Jo is to contact a pizza van and Hayley will contact Tsunami Allstars.
